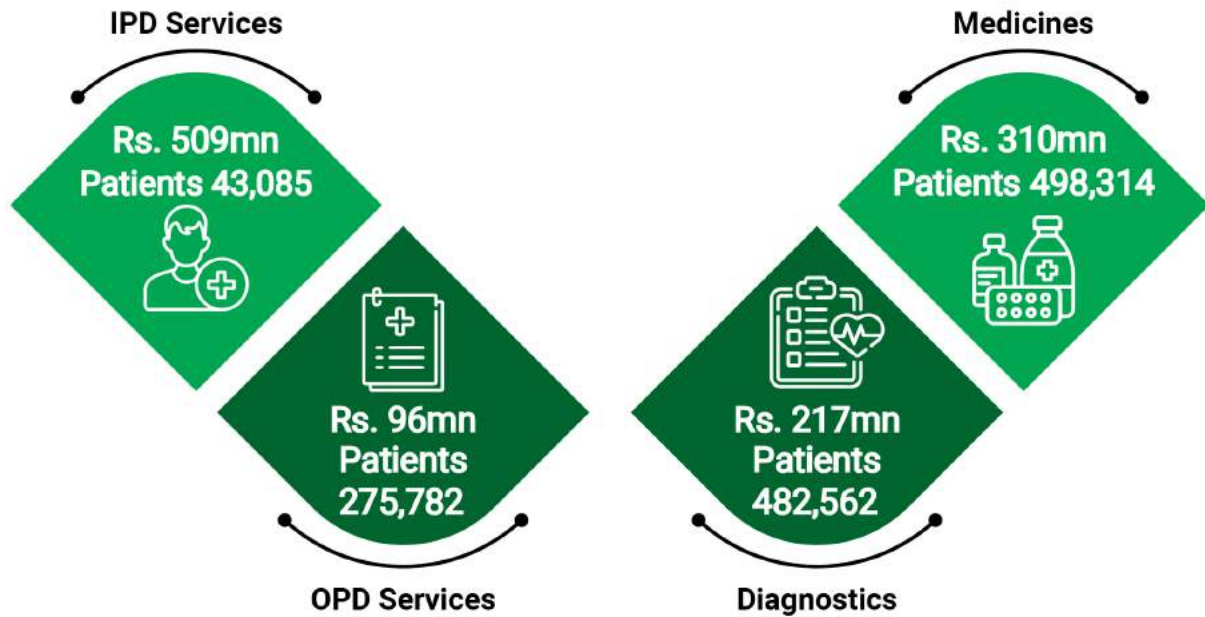

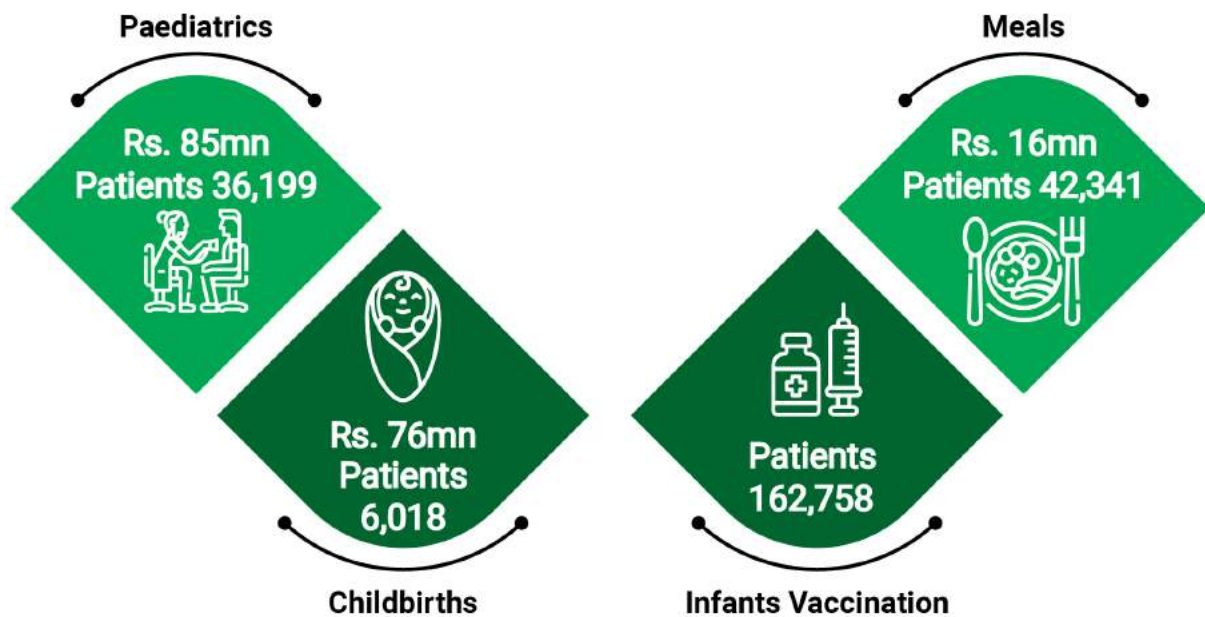

In cooperation of Sindh TB Control Program, CGH has established a center where free consultancy, diagnostic procedures and treatments are provided by qualified physicians.



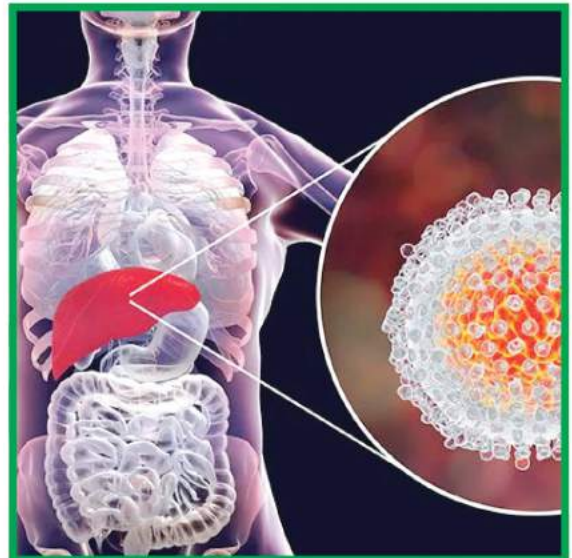

## Hepatitis "B & C"

In Pakistan, there are estimated 07 to 09 million carriers of HBV with a carrier rate of 3-5%. Chronic HBV infection, if not treated, progresses to Cirrhosis and may also lead to HCC.

Pakistan has the second largest burden of Hepatitis C globally, with a nationwide prevalence of 4.8%. Chronic HCV infection results in Cirrhosis and a major risk factor of HCC. Treatment of chronic HCV with Novel Agent is promising.

CGH is contributing in this national cause to control and eliminate this disease from the country and provides free medical treatment to deserving Hepatitis patients.

# Success Stories

## A Life Saved

Danish aged 32, with a diagnosed case of Dengue Fever was admitted in a Government Hospital at Hyderabad. His condition worsened when he started to profusely bleeding per rectum and fell unconscious. Considering the state of affairs at hospital and his worsening condition, the patient was evacuated to CGH through ambulance in Emergency.

When received at CGH Emergency he was unconscious and was bleeding profusely. On investigation his **Hemoglobin was just 2 gms/dl**. He was diagnosed as a case of Dengue Hemorrhagic Shock and immediately shifted to ICU.



In ICU, after multiple blood and platelets transfusions he regained consciousness. As a result of continuous efforts and care by CGH medical team for 04 to 05 days his bleeding subsided, platelets and hemoglobin increased, and he was safely discharged from the hospital.

## A Mother Saved

Rabia aged 23, came in labor pain with full-term pregnancy along with fever. This was her second child and she was admitted to CGH as a booked case. She was also Dengue positive with very low platelets. Her condition was critical but Dr. Rafia accepted this challenge and an emergency surgery was done due to fetal distress. A baby girl of 03 kg was delivered but the baby was in severe distress and had to be put on ventilator in Intensive Care Unit where the baby was expired on the same day.



Before and after surgery, multiple units of platelets were transfused to stabilize Rabia. Due to severe complications her condition deteriorated and she was moved to the Intensive Care Unit where she was kept on mechanical ventilator for 07 days.

The physician along with doctors were present for further care and guidance all the time, she was undergoing fresh blood collection in her abdomen which was also treated simultaneously. **She remained on ventilator for 7 days** but with combined team efforts of Medical and Gynae consultants she started improving and she was safely discharged from the hospital after 14 days' overall stay.



# Success Stories

## Move Without Pain

Twelve years ago, Mr. Malik Waqas, who is currently serving overseas, had an accident that fractured his femur. He underwent internal fixation with nail and screw and then plaster was applied. When the plaster was taken off after a month, it caused severe muscle spasms, the leg movements were restricted badly, and his leg became straight. Though he attended many physiotherapy sessions, there was no improvement. He was advised by a renowned Orthopedic surgeon to postpone his joint replacement till the age of 50 years.

Later, one of his friends suggested him to consult Dr. Iqbal Alam Orthopedic Surgeon at CGH. Mr. Waqas consulted his case with Dr. Iqbal and underwent a surgery. After surgery, he is now satisfied with the results as his muscle spasm has subsided and the range of movements has been restored. He is grateful to CGH, especially Dr. Iqbal Alam. Before approaching CGH he was restricted to a wheelchair and was not hopeful about his future. However after treatment and care at CGH, his life has changed to normal again by the Grace of Almighty Allah.

Now Mr. Malik Waqas refers all his acquaintances to Chiniot General Hospital and Dr. Iqbal Alam for orthopedic-related issues.
